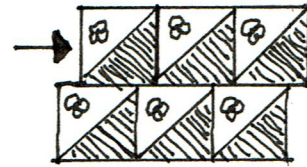
Straight Match Repeat



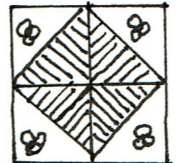
Half Drop Repeat

We'll cover two techniques for printing your own fabric, today. Hand printing & digital printing

Hand Printing

This technique can be done with different devices such as wood blocks, screen printing, stencils, or rubber stamps. With all of these, it's best to have a slightly padded printing surface. I use 2 layers of poly batting with a plastic tablecloth on top. Often the paint or ink will wick through the fabric, so make sure your printing surface is clean or at least dry. Use textile paints made for fabric. It can be found at the craft stores. After the printing is complete, allow to dry and then be sure to press with hot iron to heat set the inks before washing.

Digital Printing

Spoonflower.com is an interactive, custom digital printing company who can print your original design in your specified colors on multiple base fabrics, wallpaper or giftwrapping paper. They also have an online library consisting of thousands of designs from which you may order and custom color, if desired.
