Poinita is the mother of four children and an entrepreneur. She was born in Macon, Georgia and moved to Chattanooga in 1993. Poinita has done hair since she was young, but in 2013 she decided to turn her hobby into a career. She began a year-long program at Virginia College to pursue cosmetology.



Poinita completed her program with a 4.0 GPA and began doing hair as a career. After working for other people, Poinita learned that she wanted to be her own boss and in the summer of 2017 she opened her own salon on Wilcox Boulevard called "Glitz". She now owns, manages, and works in her salon daily. "I love doing hair. It is so interesting because you can do so much with it," she said. She has a goal to be fully staffed at her salon by the end of her first year of business.
